3. **Business arising from the minutes:**

A. **The RMN** – a list of other organisations that publish rangelands relevant material has been sent to Noelene Duckett.

B. **2025 IRC bid**

- Dana Kelly's information needs to be redrafted before it goes onto social media. **(David to action)**
- John Gavin agreed to be part of a panel to develop a bid to host the 2025 IRC. Need to identify a suitable person to lead with the development of a bid.
- A copy of the bid guidelines and template to be made available to potential bid committee members.
- A partner organisation is required eg Ecological Society of Australia
- Require a venue that will provide the conference room free of charge eg a hotel where all (most) of the delegates stay on the proviso that the conference facility is included.
- Peter Conradie is to be approached to lead the development of a bid. Dionne to forward Peter's contact details to David Phelps. **(David to action)**

C. **Adelaide Convention Centre** – a report on the possible convention centres for IRC 2025 was circulated by David to ARS Council members.

D. **International Year of Rangelands & Pastoralists** – ARS is now accredited to contribute to the UN Environmental Assembly (UNEA). Next meeting is in Nairobi, Kenya in March 2019. Dana Kelly will be attending and representing ARS.

E. **ARS Award of Excellence - Proposal**

- Revamped guidelines were written by Don Burnside and circulated to Council members. Council is happy with the guidelines, with the omission of the "*donation to a worthy cause in the rangelands.*" Proposal is to be included in the agenda for the AGM 22nd May 2019. **(Bob to action)**

F. **Paid ARS Life Membership** – Comments from Council members included:-

- A flatter subscription structure is needed for younger members
- Subscriptions for paid life members could be handled on a case by case basis

6. Reports

6.1 Membership Report (Don Burnside, Acting Membership Director)

4 February 2019

The summary – at the end of 2018

There were 209 current paid up and complimentary members – termed as ‘active’ members. Those members from 2017 who did not paid their membership during 2018 (n = 38) have been shifted to the ‘inactive’ category.

The detail

We have recruited a number of new or re-joined paid members – 16 in total – through 2018, which is encouraging. Some of these people who have joined in the last month will have their membership carried through to the end of 2019.

We have 28 complimentary members, being Editors of the Journal, RMN and Social media, the chair of the Publications Committee, Associate Editors.

Complimentary memberships for the prize winners at the RRR or ARS 2017 Conferences expired at the end of 2018. They will be encouraged to maintain their membership, with concessional registration at the ARS 2019 conference being an inducement (they have been added to the ‘still to pay in 2019’ group).

The number of Institutional Subscribers to the Journal has remained almost the same for several years.

Although the Society does not benefit financially from their patronage, through the Journal, they provide the ARS with very wide exposure across the world.

Notes on financial Report – note these accounts for calendar 2018 have not yet been audited.

- **Membership income.** This is behind budget, with 38 paying members not paying for 2018. Full paid members are 189, including those joining during the year. Some members renewed for 2019 before the end of the year.
- **Journal income.** Income has been received for two special issues of the Journal (RRR and Northern Development), and for the 2017 Conference Special Issue which will be published early in 2019. We cannot expect further income from special issues until late 2019 at the earliest.
- **Marketing and promotion expenses.** Includes payments being made to Wright Social for posts on Social Media (\$120/mth) and a payment of \$833 made to Noelene Duckett for her management of the website after Camilla Osborn's resignation and before Russell Grant's recent appointment. Jodie Ward was paid for her period at SME Editor. Further payments made to Wright Social for providing social media and to Ron Hacker and Russell Grant for travel to Sydney for discussions with Zymzen.
- **Journal expenses.** Full year payment of \$18,182 to CSIRO for publication of TRJ under the new contract. This compares favourably with full year payment of \$29,091 under the previous contract. Payment still to be made to Paul Novelly as EiC (\$4,000).
- **Newsletter Costs.** Payment of \$2,500 to Noelene Duckett.
- **Council costs.** Significantly reduced costs for communications due to switch to Webex.
- **Corporate costs.** Represents fines paid to ASIC for Don's late notification of change in Directors (resignation Carol, appointment Bob). Mea Culpa.
- **Honoraria.** Payments have been made to Don Heylen (Book keeper) - \$2,750 and Ron Hacker (Chair, Publications Committee) - \$2,500, plus reimbursement for additional small expenses incurred by Don and Ron
- **Outcome for 2018.** The un-audited P&L shows a small profit for the year of \$3,879. Given that there were net costs from the 2017 conference carried into 2018 (\$4,887), this outcome is encouraging for the future viability of the Society. This development is due almost entirely due to reduced costs for TRJ production and for communications.

Notes on financial Report for January 2019

6.3 Publications Committee Report (Ron Hacker, Chair, Publications Committee)

20 February 2019

The Publications Committee (PC) met on 6 February 2019. The following matters are forwarded for Council's information and consideration.

a. The Rangeland Journal

Last year was a good year for TRJ with all six issues of volume 40 published within the calendar year for a total of 618 pages. A contract for a special issue on total grazing pressure management in the southern rangelands of Australia, based on the outputs of two MLA-funded projects, is currently with NSW DPI and some papers are currently in preparation. This special issue should fill the gap that I have previously noted in the latter part of 2019, the other special issue for 2019 being from the Port Augusta conference. No other special issues are confirmed as yet although CSIRO Publishing has advised that there is still interest in China in a special issue arising from a conference on grassland restoration conducted last year. This, together with the issue arising from the Canberra conference, may fill the slots available for 2020.

I have advised CSIRO Publishing that in 2019-20 we would be happy to limit conference promotion of TRJ to the Canberra conference and the ESA conference, but would hope to mount a strong promotional campaign at the IRC in Nairobi in 2020-21.

All appointments related to the journal are now current after a number of Associate Editors and Advisory Editors accepted extensions. Several Advisory Editors have agreed to assist me and the Editor-in-Chief to improve the presentation of TRJ by reading several papers and highlighting typographical and grammatical errors, and issues of English expression.

b. Range Management Newsletter

Nothing to report from the Editor.

Don Burnside has advised that the recommendations made in the discussion paper *Revitalising the Range Management Newsletter* were accepted by Council at its last meeting, with one minor amendment. I presume this decision will be ratified when the minutes of the last meeting are accepted at the current meeting. I will then forward them to Noelene to begin implementation.

c. Website

The situation with ZymZen has become untenable. At the present time they are not responding to emails and Janine Howard's mobile is apparently switched off. The PC passed a motion on 6 February recommending that Council call tenders for another provider. After consultation with the President I distributed a call for tenders to 5 potential providers on 11 February with tenders to close at COB 20 February. It may be possible to prepare a report for Council to consider that evening although an out-of-session decision will probably be necessary.

We should not underestimate the significance of this situation, the likely cost or the likely complexity of the move. While I understand it is possible to transfer the site relatively cheaply it would remain on the current

platform which is no longer supported (a situation identical to that which prompted out last tender for web site redesign and the move from LinkDigital to Fat Beehive, now ZymZen). To transfer the site to an industry standard platform like Wordpress apparently involves a complete rebuild and would probably cost a similar amount to our last move.

d. Social media

Sarah Moles attended her first PC meeting as Social Media Editor and is settling well into the role. In keeping with the conditions of her appointment I will review her progress in late February-early March. She anticipates making three posts a week to the various platforms (at least Facebook and Twitter) and sees no need at the moment to continue the arrangement with Wright Social under which Heidi Wright supplied one post a week and the SME contributed \$500 from the Honorarium towards the cost.

There was some discussion regarding the type of posts that should be made and Sarah was directed to both the Social Media User's Handbook and the Articles and Memorandum of Association for statements of the Society's general objectives and specific objectives for social media. While some members of PC favoured posting controversial or topical material I have indicated that no material that is overtly political should be posted or retweeted (although the boundary is inevitably fuzzy)

e. General

I have advised the PC, and the President separately, that I will not seek reappointment for a third term when my current term expires on 30 June.
